**FINAL PROJECT DOCUMENTATION**

**DUE DEC. 7**

For your final project each of you will create a site specific work that we will tour on December 12. As agreed, each of you will post background information about your project to the web for the reviewers and your fellow classmates to review in advance of the tour. In addition you should be prepared to talk briefly about your project on-site.

**Web Site** (due Dec. 7)

Create a clear web page detailing information about your project. Please use the template on the class wiki (<http://inyourpocket.pbwiki.com/Final-Project-Documentation>)

1. Title
2. Artist Name
3. Project Description.
  - a. Provide the title of your piece and as concise a description as possible.
  - b. Define your project as a mapping, probe, tour, performance or hybrid of these artistic strategies.
  - c. How does your project engage with the themes of the class (Hertzian space, mobile media, etc)?
  - d. Describe your site (Union Square) or site typology (alleys, parks, etc). What is your interest in this site and how do you see your intervention altering its' current dynamics?
  - e. What is the relationship of your project to your site and the urban landscape in general?
  - f. What new perspectives or relationships do you hope to provoke through your piece?
4. Map Link to a map of the route of your project (use Mapquest multi-stop route builder)
5. Create a downloadable PDF file measuring standard letter size (8 1/2 x 11). This page should feature:
  - a. Your project title
  - b. An abbreviated project description.
  - c. The location of the site for the tour.
  - d. The project web site address.
  - e. Any other relevant information that you would like the reviewers, and your classmates, to consider while viewing your project on-site.
6. Please include documentation of your research and experiments.
